

## Presidential Fellows Program Work Flow

1. The Graduate School requests nominations from programs. All programs are eligible to nominate doctoral students for this award. Nominations are submitted through Grad Status, mid-January of each year.
2. Nominees are reviewed by a panel of faculty who meet in early Feb of each year. Programs are notified of the outcomes by mid-February of each year.
3. Presidential Fellows are offered a five-year commitment, \$27,000/ academic year (\$23,625 in year 01), assuming adequate progress towards the degree. Support for the Presidential Fellows Program is provided according to the following schedule (\*combination of assistantship and fellowship funds):

4. Graduate School uses template letter to offer Presidential Fellows Assistantship to selected fellows (on or about Feb. 15, yearly).
  - a. \$27,000/ year fiscal year compensation for 1/3 time effort for five years, assuming satisfactory progress to degree
  - b. Tuition waiver
  - c. Enrollment, health insurance requirements per other assistantships
  - d. Professional development requirements (RCR training, individual development plan)
  - e. Assistantship assignment *must* be limited to the high priority area of research/ scholarship (no teaching or other duties for duration of support)
5. Upon acceptance of offer, Graduate School will administer the Presidential Fellows per administration of its other award programs.
