RESPONSIBLE CONDUCT OF RESEARCH REQUIREMENT

Beginning Fall 2016, newly matriculating graduate students who receive financial support through an assistantship/fellowship that is supported partially or fully with funds from the Graduate School must complete training in the Responsible Conduct of Research (RCR). This training must be completed within the first year of enrollment. Continuation of funding beyond the first year is contingent upon demonstrated completion of this requirement. The table below lists several courses offered at UGA that meet the Graduate School requirement.
